

Erste Schritte mit SDS Manager

Wie migriere ich unseren aktuellen Sicherheitsdatenblatt-Ordner zu SDS Manager?

Wenn Sie bereits Sicherheitsdatenblatt-Ordner für jeden Ihrer Standorte haben, können Sie die Datei des Sicherheitsdatenblatt-Ordners einfach in einen Standort in unserem SDS Inventory Manager hochladen. Wir lesen das importierte PDF automatisch aus, ermitteln, welche Sicherheitsdatenblätter sich in der Datei befinden, und fügen sie dem Standort automatisch hinzu.

Mit dieser Methode können Sie Ihren SDS Inventory Manager in wenigen Minuten mit Tausenden von Sicherheitsdatenblättern füllen. Die einzige Voraussetzung ist, dass Sie einen Sicherheitsdatenblatt-Ordner für jeden Standort in Ihrem Unternehmen haben.
