



Getting Started with SDS Manager

How to Create an Avery/Brady Label for an SDS PDF?

Here is how to create an Avery/Brady label for an SDS PDF:



Step 1: In **SDS Inventory Manager**, open the **“All My SDSs”** or **“Manage SDS Library”** page.

Step 2: Find the product for which you want to create a label with a QR code, then click on the  icon next to the SDS to add it to the print list.

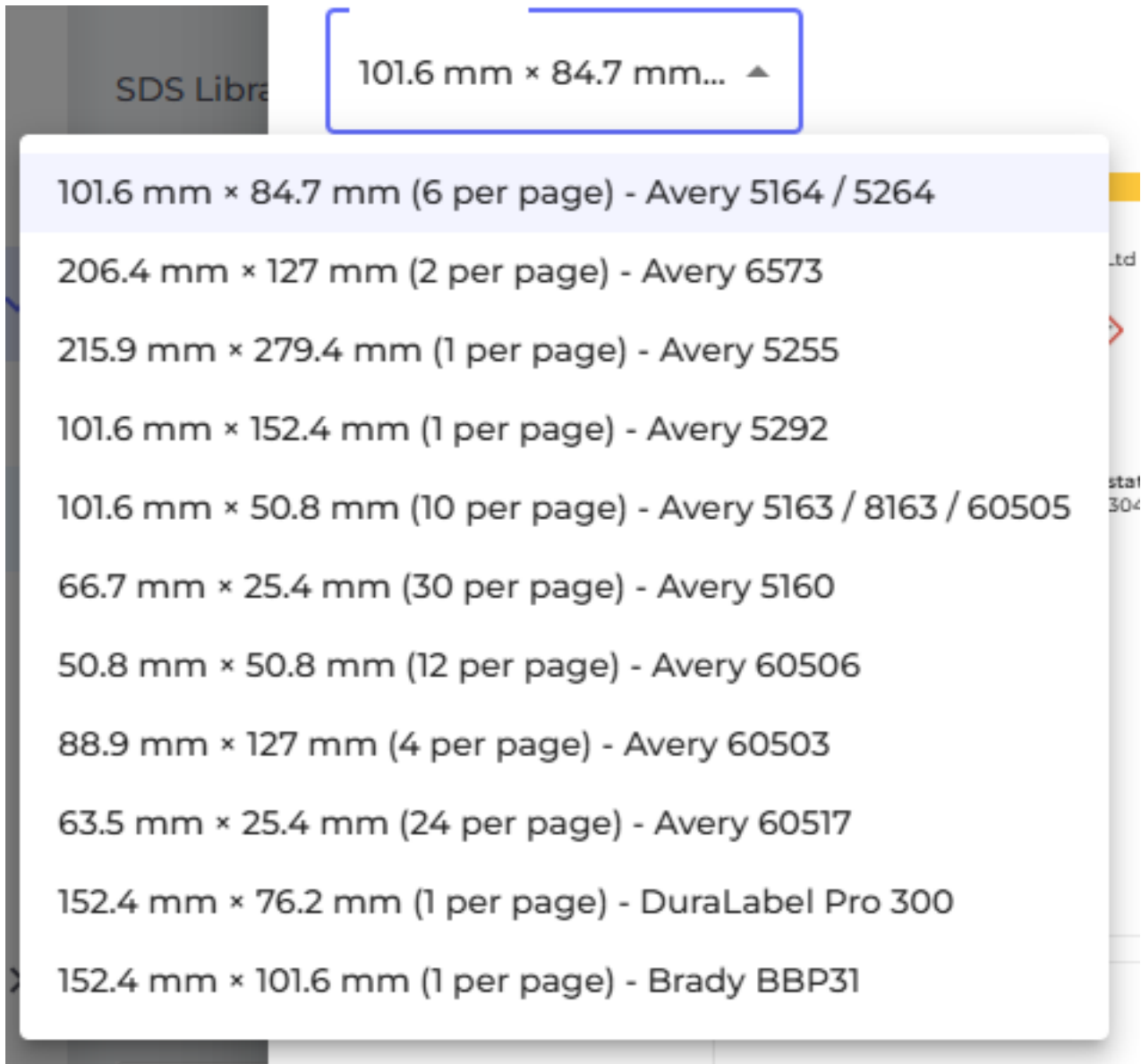
