## How to Create an Avery/Brady Label for an SDS PDF?


Here is how to create an Avery/Brady label for an SDS PDF:

**Step 1:** In **SDS Inventory Manager**, open the **“All My SDSs”** or **“Manage SDS Library”** page.

**Step 2:** Find the product for which you want to create a label with a QR code, then click on the



icon next to the SDS to add it to the print list.

icon near the



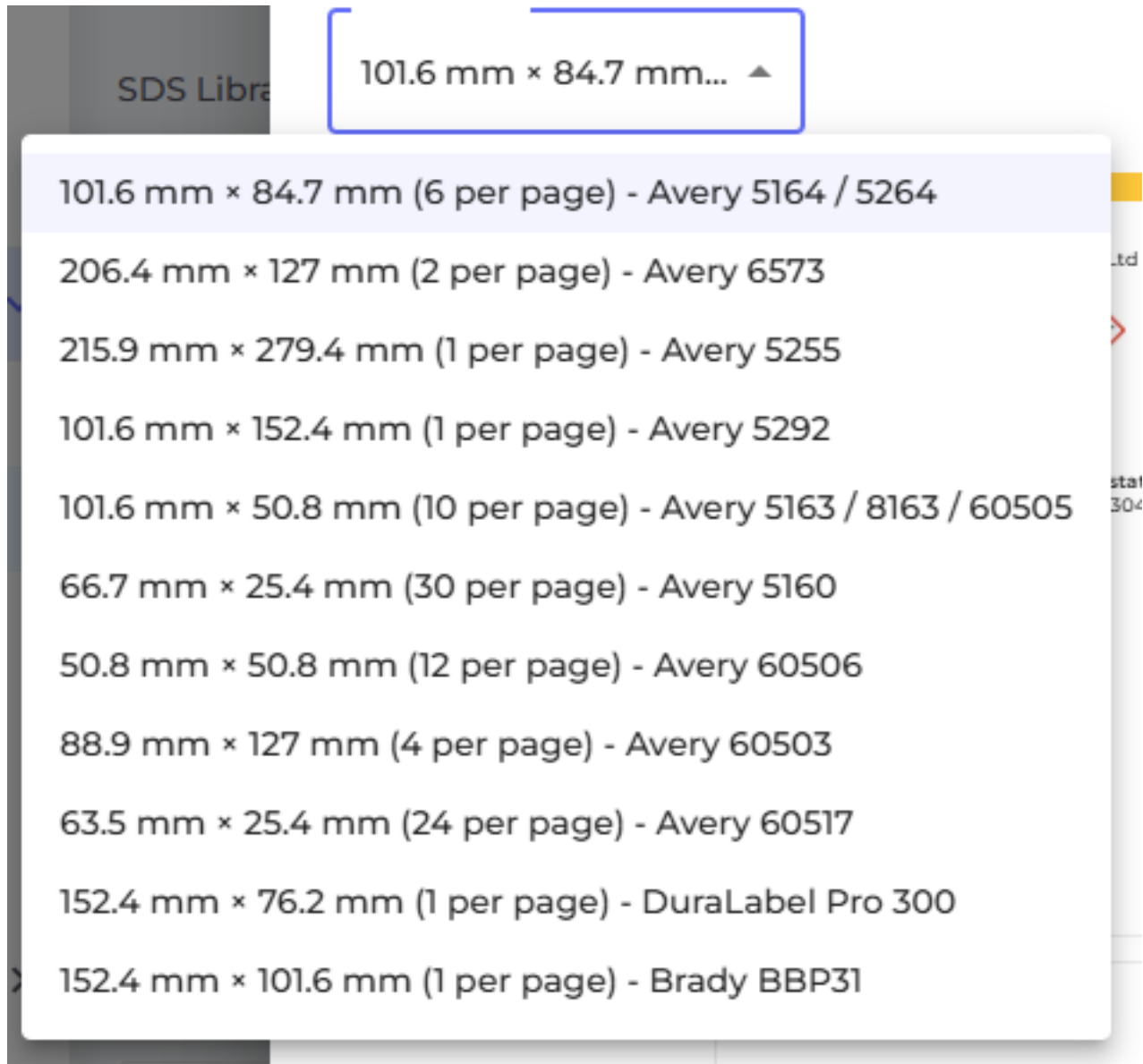
button to open the modified print page. Here, you can customize the print format for the selected SDSs.
