

Migrating our SDS files to SDS Manager

How do I migrate our current SDS vendor library to SDS Manager?

There are two ways to move your Safety Data Sheet library from your current SDS Management system to the SDS Manager.

Migrate your SDSs using SDS binders generated in your current SDS Management system

The simplest method of migrating from a competitor to SDS Manager is to generate an SDS-binder for each location you have SDS in your current system. All systems for SDS inventory management have the ability to create such PDF files that contain all SDS related to a location.

In SDS Manager you can simply [upload the SDS-binder file](#) (require login).


SDS Manager will read the SDS Binder file (PDF) and add all the Safety Data Sheets found in the SDS Binder file to your SDS Manager library. You repeat the process for each location if your SDSs are stored in multiple locations in your current library.

Import your SDS files

The SDS Manager offers a distinctive feature that allows you to easily populate your online library with Safety Data Sheets by directly importing PDF files (electronic versions of Safety Data Sheets). This eliminates the need for manual typing.

If your SDS files are organized in a folder hierarchy, you can compress the entire folder structure into a ZIP file. We will then automatically establish a location structure that mirrors your folder arrangement, adding the SDS to each location in a manner consistent with how they are stored on your file server.

When SDS Manager imports the SDS files, we analyze and extract all the content found within the SDS files, making it accessible in your new SDS library.
