

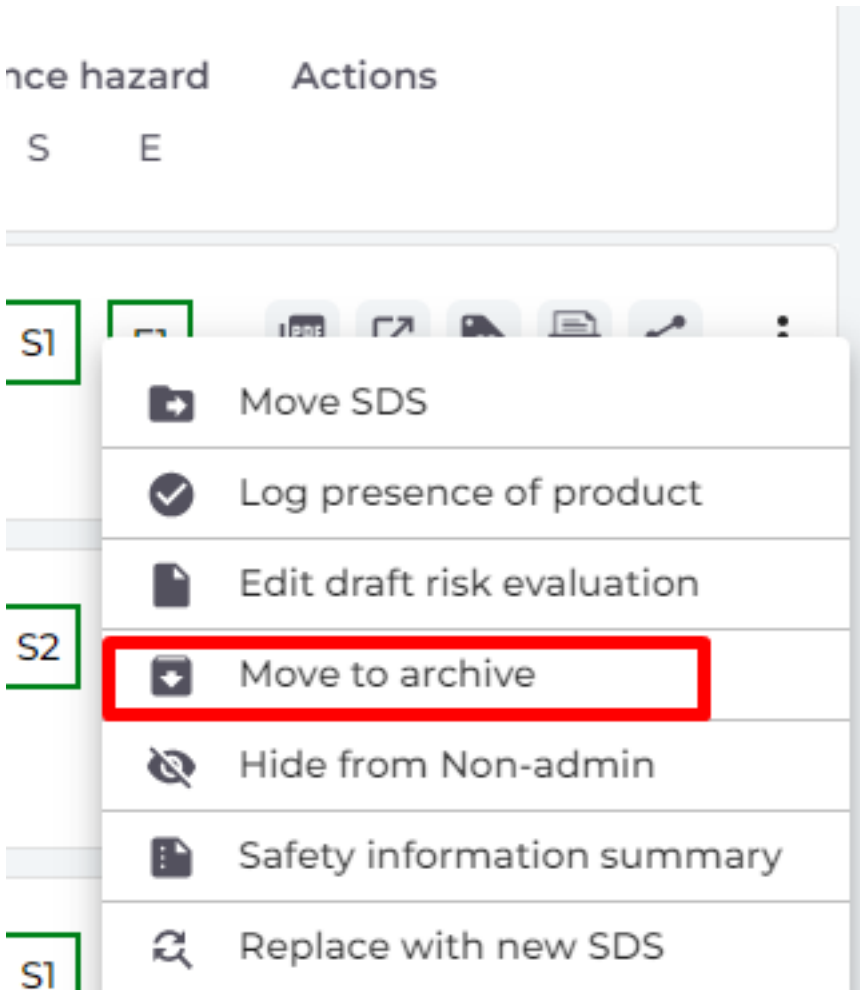
How to archive SDSs

"How do I archive SDSs that are no longer in use? Can I archive SDSs that are not yet approved? (Can I archive SDSs that are not yet approved?)?"

When you have an SDS that is no longer in use, you can archive it. Archiving an SDS means that it is no longer active and is not visible to users who do not have administrative rights.
