How can I add chemicals to SDS Manager without an SDS?

You can manually enter the product/chemical information without a SDS.

Open 'Manage SDS Library' and choose a location for this new product.

Then, click 'Add Safety Data Sheet' and select 'Show other methods to add Safety Data Sheets to location.'

After the product information is saved, you can email the supplier of the product for the SDS PDF file, they will be willing to send you the SDS file.

When you have already obtained the SDS file, in 'Manage SDS library' menu, select 'SDS request' then click 'Find SDS' for the product.
